### **NEW VENUE FOR PLASTIC PIPES MOSCOW 2013**

Increased participation has prompted a new venue for PLASTIC PIPES MOSCOW 2013. This convention and exhibition will now be hosted at the **Hotel Nikolskaya Kempinski** Moscow. It is the first affiliated event from the International Pipes Conference and will take place during 3 – 4 October 2013. A new sponsor has also been announced: Rollepaal, an international company that specializes in plastic pipe extrusion machinery equipment.

A wide ranging platform of speakers and subjects has been announced. In addition to a complete analysis of markets in Russia, Ukraine, Belarus, and Kazakhstan, technical presentations will include PE pipes used in the Middle East oil and gas industry, new developments in PVC oriented pipe systems and the future challenges for large diameter pipes.

Fares Kilzie, Chairman of the Board of Directors of Creon Energy will deliver the opening address followed by a review of the most recent developments in plastic pipe technology alongside experience gained by major utility, sewer, building and civil engineering sectors in the Region.

Zoran Davidovski, chairman for the organizing committee explains: "What we see in the Regional pipe market is a consolidation across all segments in favor of plastic pipe technology. The old is making way for the new. Performance and durability are everything and that perception is being realized. Our conference will highlight the various market trends and explain the latest environmental findings that will help to determine the trade dynamics now and in the future."

The versatility of plastic pipe materials is such that the range of applications and new systems is continuously widening. One particular presentation will focus on the scale and scope of market growth in Composite Pipes.

Meanwhile, organizers of the Moscow event report that participation has already exceeded expectations with extra hotel accommodation having been reserved. In addition to Rollepaal, the Baerlocher group and LyondellBasel that became first sponsors of the convention, the German company of M.O.L Gummiverarbeitung is now an official partner of the event.

PLASTIC PIPES MOSCOW 2013 is organized by INVENTRA, part of the CREON Energy group that specializes in providing advisory services in the markets for plastics and plastics converting.

The Plastic Pipes Conference is the world's largest and most international convention and exhibition event of its kind. Held every two years, the next major venue will be in Chicago, 22-24 September 2014.
